





James 1:17 - James 1:17 is quoted with this beautiful image of a baby cradled in an adult's hand. *"Every good and perfect gift is from above."*






Featured work by artist Julie Chen. Simple classic designs in traditional walnut espresso-colored frames with sepia print artistry and rich textured glaze.




"Be Like Christ" - In this framed work, artist Julie Chen quotes Philippians 2:5-11 as a reminder of the power of the Word and the beauty of creation.
