

6 Ways Your Church Can Support New Beginnings



Host a “Baby Shower” for New Beginnings

- Select a time frame for people to drop off donations at your church.
- Items needed can be found on our Target Registry (first name: *New*, last name: *Beginnings*) or on our website: www.homeformothers.com



Hold a “Life Observance Sunday” Worship Service

- Pastor Robert Fleischmann, National Director of Christian Life Resources and founder of New Beginnings, could guest preach at your service.
- Ask for a special offering for New Beginnings.



Participate in the “Change for Life” Project

- We will supply you with baby bottles or coin boxes that you can distribute to your members. They can take them home with them for a designated period of time.
- After time period is up, collect the change, cash it in, and send the collected funds to New Beginnings.



Organize Volunteers at your Church

- Volunteers are needed to staff the home and oversee residents, mentor or tutor residents, participate in group activities, perform home maintenance, etc.
- One volunteer is needed from every church to act as an information liaison. This person would coordinate with the staff at New Beginnings to bring promotional material, donations, and other information between their church and New Beginnings.



Host an Event at your Church

- Plan any fellowship/fundraising event of your choosing and have the proceeds benefit New Beginnings (Advent dinner, bake sale, etc.)



Start a Sewing Circle

- Although baby blankets are always welcome, at this time we have a greater need for other items that can be homemade, such as: pack 'n play fitted mattress sheets (patterns can be found online), baby wash cloths, burp rags, or twin-size extra-long blankets for the moms' beds.
