

New Beginnings is very organized and Christian-based and I have gained knowledge about my Lord and Savior since starting in the program. Hi, My name is Bryonna and my daughters' names are A'Nylah & A'Kylah. At a young age I was removed out of my home and placed into foster care. Once I entered foster care I felt like I gave up on myself. I started slipping in school, hanging out with the wrong group of friends, and not caring about anything anymore. I started smoking and drinking a lot, because I felt like that was an easy way out. Once I aged out of foster care, I really hit rock bottom. I started bouncing around from house to house. Then, in 2014, I ended up pregnant. I was so scared because I didn't have a stable home or an income. As I became further along in my pregnancy, I felt like I had to make a change for my babies. I'm bringing not just one baby, but two babies, into the world. After a while I came across *New Beginnings*. *New Beginnings* has helped me feel better about parenting twins in such a short amount of time. I'm also trying to get right with God and I feel like this is just the place to do that. This place has made me realize that I can be a great mother to my babies.
