I must admit that I have never had a green thumb. Keeping a houseplant alive always seemed like an impossible task. Despite my lack of gardening skills, each year at New Beginnings we work with the residents to plant flowers, plants, and vegetables around the home. Last year, we planted carrots for the first time. When planting carrots, the instructions say that you must thin the carrots after they have grown about four inches. In other words, you need to pluck about half of them from the ground to make enough space for those left over to grow properly. I couldn't accept the idea that plucking some from the ground would kill them, so I just let them be. At the end of the season, they were the most pitiful looking carrots! I hadn't given them room to grow, and by doing so, I ruined the whole lot.

For some reason, this experience felt like God was giving me a life lesson – don't ignore instructions for growth! As Christians in today's world, we must continually grow in grace or risk being carried away from the truth of our Lord. At times, this might require an earthly thinning of our own; we must carefully consider the people, things, and thoughts

we surround ourselves with. To grow properly we must focus on growing spiritually and personally by God's stability and grace. Our instructions for growth are clear: "Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ" (2 Peter 3:18a).

At New Beginnings, helping the mothers to grow in the knowledge of Christ Jesus is our primary mission. We know that all growth comes from the Lord, and that growth begins in his Word. In fact, once a mother is given the tools to grow spiritually, her growth in other areas seems to fall into place. Constance, Shawna, and Julie are examples of growth in different areas of the program, and they share their spiritual growth, parenting growth, and educational growth in this issue.

We pray that the mothers at New Beginnings continue to grow and mature with Christ in the forefront. As Ephesians 4:15-16 says, "Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work."
