I was feeling unworthy and hopeless, and nothing seemed to be going right. My living conditions were unsavory and not a good fit for me, let alone a baby. I looked at all the possibilities but none of them felt right in my mind or my heart. That's when I was sent a link about New Beginnings. I felt it was too good to be true, but I still wanted to find out more. I called and was greeted by a warm voice on the other end. We talked for an hour before setting a date for an interview. I was so nervous, but this was my last hope. I was not only blown away by how much the people cared, but also how kind and thoughtful they were. Then I toured the house, and it was so nice. It was everything that I wanted and needed. I was so driven to do whatever it would take to be assisted in my journey. Then the day came that I could finally move in and I was so thrilled. As soon as I walked through the door, a peace filled me and I knew I was secure.



Updates from Shamya & Julie

My name is Shamya and I have a baby boy named Aiden who is almost 5 months old. He was born on 3/26/19 and he weighed 5 pounds 11 oz. Becoming a mother changed my whole life. He is the best blessing I've ever received. I'm a single mother and before I came to *New Beginnings* I thought that once I had my son that I was always going to struggle.

When I found out about New Beginnings, I knew that I had to find a way to join the program. First of all, I needed a new beginning for me and my son so that he could have a better life. I also knew I needed to get my life together, so being here changed a lot for me and my son. We are happy and also grateful that we got this opportunity to live in a safe place and get all the things that the staff has given me. I'm also happy and grateful for everything New Beginnings has done to help me find out what I wanted to do for my career



and where I want my son and me to be in life. I know that I wouldn't have gotten where I am now if it wasn't for them caring so much about me. I honestly encourage other women to let *New Beginnings* help you and show you that everything you have struggled with is possible to overcome. If you are grieving, give them the chance to show you that everything will get better. It IS possible to fix your life for you and your child.

When I was about to give up because I wasn't getting anywhere in Illinois, I was crying and had one number to call for help (*New Beginnings*). When I called and talked to the lady who answered the phone she asked if I was able to move to Wisconsin and I said yes. When I heard that they had an opening I instantly felt relief and hope. If it wasn't for this program I don't know where my son and I would be right now. I never thought I'd have a second chance at a career and a better life so thank you to you all!
