Moving to a new location requires change on multiple levels including a change in scenery, variations in day-to-day activities, and sometimes even modifications in long-term goals. Although change seems intimidating at first, it can lead to wonderful outcomes. We are proud to announce that the program at *New Beginnings* continues to grow to meet the needs of our new location in Milwaukee. For the past few months, our staff has worked to collaborate with members of the community in an effort to advance the *New Beginnings'* program.

The program requirements remain the same; however, our program aims to focus attention on providing educational services to our residents. In addition to mandatory morning devotions, individual Bible study, group nights, and weekly goals, *New Beginnings* now requires that residents attend school to obtain Literacy Services; a GED, Associate's or Bachelor's Degree; or, some form of vocational training. Rather than requiring the mothers to work while in the program, we are collaborating with the Adult Learning Center, Milwaukee Area Technical College, and Wisconsin Lutheran College to educate our residents so that they can ultimately obtain employment that allows for self-sufficiency.

In addition, we have secured three Resident Assistants that live at *New Beginnings* and countless volunteers from area congregations and intern students from WLC to assist with marketing and resident support. Our program is currently ready and able to accept residents.

The New Beginnings' staff waits patiently for women to apply; we are excited to start helping mothers! Interviews have begun. During the last few months our program has been preparing and developing to meet Milwaukee's needs so that we could better serve mothers in the area. We trust that the Lord will fill our home when the time is right, for He says in Philippians 4:6-7, "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." We continue to collaborate with the community to strengthen our program, increase our resources, and reinforce relationships.

If you would have asked me six months ago where I would be now, I would have said, "I will still be working as a Research Assistant with Children's Hospital, of course!" My parents live in Slinger, Wisconsin (a small town about 30 miles northwest of Milwaukee) and attend St. Paul Lutheran Church in Slinger. My brother, Nathan, was home for the weekend from college in Stevens Point, and we both were asked to sing during the Sunday service. The announcement about *New Beginnings*' search for a Home Manager was in the bulletin that Sunday. I was not looking for a new position, but after "coincidentally" running into Pastor Fleischmann, the founder of *New Beginnings*, at a nearby coffee shop following the morning service, I felt the need to discuss the position. I feel so

blessed that God chose me to help bring *New Beginnings* to Milwaukee. I thank the Lord for leading me down the right path; I know wholeheartedly that this was His plan for me.

Bethany Shiels, one of our Assistant Home Managers, had a similar experience. She worked from home as a medical transcriptionist and was laid off after a company switch to electronic medical records. Within one week of losing her job, Beth heard about *New Beginnings* and was hired shortly thereafter! Beth had no idea that God planned on using her gifts and talents to bring life to *New Beginnings* in Milwaukee.

Rachel Enstad, our second Assistant Home Manager, first heard about *New Beginnings* from her sister in DC when her church held a baby shower to support the ministry. Rachel was working at a bridal store at the time and did not expect to move into a social services career for quite some time. Little did she know, the future came much faster than expected when her parents encouraged her to apply for the position.

Beth, Rachel, and I are not quite sure what the future holds for *New Beginnings* or exactly how God will use *New Beginnings* to further His kingdom, but we know for certain that God will be holding our hands every step of the way.
