Her time here provided her with all of the skills and tools she needed to start her new, self-sufficient life. One of the greatest things we get to do at *New Beginnings* is share the truth of salvation and witness the spiritual growth of so many moms and babies. In the last year alone, three babies from *New Beginnings* were baptized at Fairview Lutheran Church in Milwaukee. We've also had eight moms participate in Bible studies and devotions, providing them with lifesaving knowledge of their Savior.

Our moms have also made significant progress in education! In 2018, three of our moms completed college courses, and another made great strides toward pursuing her GED. Two of our moms even completed additional parenting and financial literacy classes outside of *New Beginnings*. All of our residents were able to learn necessary parenting and life skills while living in a safe, stable, Christ-centered environment.

Our program has grown too! We've partnered with St. John's Lutheran Church in Milwaukee, WI, (known as St. John's on the Hillside) to hold two "Baby Pantries" so we can reach more single moms in Milwaukee. Each Baby Pantry includes a devotion as a way to share God's Word with all of these moms and their children. In September, we hosted our first annual Wine & Dine event which was a huge success! We're looking forward to our next one on September 19.

All of these accomplishments have been made possible because of your support. Thanks to your generosity, four healthy baby boys were born in 2018, while their moms were living at *New Beginnings*. We were able to make a difference that will last generations in so many lives! Thank you for making that possible by supporting our ministry!
