"And the God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, after you have suffered a little while, will himself restore you and make you strong, firm and steadfast. To him be the power for ever and ever. Amen." (1 Peter 5: 10-11).

God will provide. We see examples of this various times in the Bible. The story that first comes to mind is that of Job. Job lost everything – his possessions, his house, his cattle, and even his children. Despite these trials, Job remained faithful to the Lord, and the Lord provided (Job 1). Another example is Paul who suffered by being beaten, stoned, left without food or shelter, and even lost at sea after a shipwreck (2 Corinthians 11:16-33). Again, God provided.

When mothers apply for our program I often hear stories about the difficult times the mothers have faced in their lifetime, some of which are difficult to comprehend. I cannot imagine what each mother was going through emotionally, physically, and spiritually during those difficult times. Interestingly, many mothers find *New Beginnings* during the worst times, which is nothing short of God's grace. In fact,

Shaneka once said, "I had gotten pregnant and lost my job and my apartment. I began to question myself on how these things could happen when I was getting ready to bring something so precious into the world. I had gathered it was time for a new chapter. God had to strip everything that I thought was important for me to realize how important He is."

During a mother's time at *New Beginnings*, she grows spiritually and begins to hold fast to her faith even in difficult times. Later in this issue you will read about Letisha's and Allesundrea's stories, which are both wonderful examples of ways that the Lord provided for them. As soon as they held fast to their faith, wonderful things began to happen. They began to realize that we are never promised a life without the hard times, but we do know that the Lord continues to walk with us – and sometimes carries us – through the darkness. The future isn't so scary after all because we know that God provides.

After being in 13 foster homes from the age of 4, I aged out of foster care at 17 years old with no support or any idea of what to do next. From 17 years old until my adult age, my life was very unstable. I moved from place to place and shelter to shelter. Although being a very smart and ambitious woman, I was forced to put my education on hold to support myself. At the age of 27, with God's help, I was able to break away from an abusive relationship.

I am 28 years old now and 7 months pregnant. About two months ago, I had no idea how I would be able to support my baby boy financially. I knew that only with a high school diploma and working a minimum-wage job, things would be very hard and in some sense impossible. God showed me that he had a higher plan for me and directed me to *New Beginnings - A Home for Mothers*.

I have been here for a little over a month and started parenting classes twice a week, developed a healthier relationship with God (through church and devotions), and signed up to attend school to complete my accounting degree starting this summer. Without the worries of having a roof over my head, I not only have been able to focus on my educational goals, but on my parenting skills and my health as well. With no more self-doubt I am very optimistic about me and my son's future!
