But we can pray for help, because it is through God's love that we are able to love others fiercely. "He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?" (Romans 8:32). Let us be a reflection of God's love and the gifts he has given us by loving others fiercely – and by loving God even more.
