And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; or if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it. Now you are the body of Christ and members individually."

So, what do we do? We stay connected. Much like we do when a loved one who has moved to another state, we still find a way to stay in touch. We write, email, call, and video chat to maintain the bond of fellowship and to encourage one another in the performance of good works (Ephesians 2:10). We cherish the bond we share when we are gathered together in worship. When unable to gather, we still encourage.

Meanwhile, the babies at New Beginnings are blooming as they grow in a safe, Christian home, and the mothers of New Beginnings are blooming as they learn about their Savior! The women at New Beginnings are continuing with career coaching and Christian counseling, and they have just completed their parenting class! The work continues.

OUR RESPONSE TO COVID-19

New Beginnings took the necessary steps to protect our residents, staff, volunteers, and donors during the COVID-19 pandemic. We canceled social events, practiced social distancing, moved the career coaching and parenting classes to an online platform, video conferenced the moms' continuing Bible classes with Pastor Robinson from Fairview Ev. Lutheran Church in Milwaukee, allowed the staff to work from home and communicate with the residents via telephone or videoconferencing, and restricted visitors and volunteers from entering New Beginnings.

In addition, we asked people to hold off bringing in-kind items to New Beginnings unless they could go through an enhanced cleaning and disinfection procedure. By the time you read this issue, we may have already lifted those restrictions.
