


When furthering their education either in the college or technical school sectors, these residents for the first time learn to value their efforts – and they begin to get a sense of their own self-respect and pride in the process. They realize that by taking control of their lives, at the very least completing their GED, they become positive role models for their children. They can someday teach their child the value of education, as well as the positive outcome that such efforts give them. They can say with pride that they completed something important in their lives and, as a result, made a better life for themselves and their children.

Another change the women experience during their time at New Beginnings is when they come to realize that, despite their unplanned pregnancies, sexual relations are rightfully reserved as God's gift to those who are married. As a result, they begin to re-evaluate their relationships, specifically the way they handle dating. They gain control over their decisions and bodies — with a new determination to follow God's command of abstinence until marriage.

Not only do the New Beginnings' residents look at dating in a different light, they realize that in order to take control of their lives they need to "weed" out some of the negative influences in their social circles. Although many of them still remain friends with those from their former days, they begin to notice their friends follow different goals and morals than they do. Each night the residents ask each other for prayer requests, and more often than not, they request strength to separate themselves from

people who aren't on the same path as they are now. They thank God that He gives them wisdom, with His help, to avoid life's temptations.

The ultimate "take control" moment in these women's lives is when they respond to the working of the Holy Spirit in their hearts and begin to make God-pleasing choices. The mothers are taught the truth of Scripture that salvation is God's free gift apart from works. They are also taught to



respond to that gift with lives of service and praise. These mothers begin to understand that although making godly decisions in life may not necessarily be the easiest ones, they know that Jesus is by their side through the entire process. What a wonderful realization that Christ is always with them and that they are never alone!
