Over the past three years I have seen many residents enter and leave the *New Beginnings*' program. Some leave earlier than others, but those who graduate from the program truly find a new beginning in their lives. Many of the women — when they first enter — think a year is going to take forever. But before they know it a month passes, then six months, and soon they find themselves at their graduation date. Many comment they had no idea how quickly the past twelve months could have passed!

As a staff member I see the personal, parenting, and spiritual growth they all make. While the residents may not see it during their stay, they do see it when they are out on their own once again. They find the strength to resist the temptations that are often still there from when they first entered the program — whether it is

drugs, alcohol, unhealthy relationships, etc. They also realize where the strength comes from. They no longer rely on themselves to get through the tough situations.

Rather, they have a three-person team on their side — Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. What an amazing blessing!

Not only do these women make tremendous strides in their spiritual life but also in their personal and family lives. They are able to spend their time at *New Beginnings* learning what true love is through Christ and modeling that to themselves and to their children. When I see these graduated residents at church, the grocery store, or a visit back at the home I see how well adjusted they and their children are. This strength does not come from them but rather through Jesus.

The staff and residents sing the hymn mentioned above when a resident leaves the program, whether they leave early or at their graduation. While we may not see the fruit of our works here on earth, we have the assurance of faith that we will, like the hymn states, meet again if nowhere else than in heaven.

I give thanks to God for the ministry here at *New Beginnings* and for those who support us.


HOME MANAGER: Full-time paid position begins June 1, 2011.

Before finding out I was pregnant, I was living a life full of lies, pain and regret. In February of 2010, I was kicked out of my parent's house; I saw it coming due to the fact that I had once again relapsed into my old lifestyle of drugs, alcohol and sex. In April of 2010, I found out that I was 5 weeks pregnant...



Hi, my name is Kelsey, and I'm a 19-year-old mother, to my beautiful son Adam. Since coming to New Beginnings in September of 2010, I can say that my life has made a complete 180° turn. In that same month I had started a GED program, and was searching for a job. By October, I had a temporary job position at Party City! And by November I had received my GED, and had passed every test my first try. By December, with my due date on the 23rd, I had another temporary job position at Big Lots!
