## Here We Grow... To Serve Our Residents

The women of Saint Paul Lutheran Church in Tacoma, Washington have always had a heart for mothers and babies, so when some of the women suggested a special offering for *New Beginnings*, it was greeted with great excitement. *New Beginning* bottles were ordered and then placed in the church entryway at the end of February. In short order they all disappeared! And then they started reappearing... filled with coins and bills! They were emptied by volunteers and placed back out again, many of them only to disappear and return again!

The offering took place from the beginning of March until Mother's Day (May 8). In the process, 47 dollars, 19 half-dollars, 1,694 quarters, 2,401 dimes, 1,518 nickels, and 11,556 pennies came in for a total of \$911.56! Volunteers took the coins to Coinstar machines in town and converted them into gift certificates, which enables the full amount to be paid back (instead of a percentage going to Coinstar). They then wrote a check to *New Beginnings* to cover the cost of the vouchers, and the entire amount of change was able to be easily converted into a gift for *New Beginnings*.

What a joy it was for my wife Sheryl and me to hand-deliver the check to *New Beginnings* on a vacation trip to Colorado in June. We toured the facility and met some of the moms and babies that the money would be helping. Pictures and stories of *New Beginnings* will certainly be shared with the congregation, and there is no doubt that they will be doing this again.

What a blessing for the ladies (and men) of Saint Paul's who contributed this special gift out of love for the Lord and for others. It is their prayer that the gift they gave will be a blessing to all involved with *New Beginnings* as well.


