HERE WE GROW...

As sinful human beings, we often like to take the credit when things go as planned and pass the blame when things do not turn out as well. Unfortunately, because we live in a sinful world, we cannot always avoid sadness, pain or tragedy. Fortunately, God IS in control, and Jeremiah assures us that God has "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future" (Jeremiah 29:11). A future of hope in God is what we strive to impart on all of the New Beginnings residents. Through daily devotion, regular Bible study and weekly church attendance, the Holy Spirit instills and grows faith within their hearts and those of their children. We implemented our Phase II program about one year ago, and thanks to God it is already yielding incredible results. The Phase II program was originally designed to provide existing residents in good standing with more time - specifically, more time to heal and grow in a loving Christian environment, as well as pursue an education or career to assist them in achieving self-sufficiency once they exit the program. Phase II residents are required to adhere to basic Phase I responsibilities, such as attending church,

completing weekly Bible studies, following curfew, and performing weekly chores. They are also given additional responsibilities and have the opportunity to obtain privileges. Phase II residents must work an evening shift at the house every other Friday and set a good example for the Phase I residents. They are also required to attend a community, vocational or technical college or obtain a full-time job. In order to facilitate finding a job or starting school, they are no longer required to attend morning group devotions; however, they are required to conduct daily personal devotions. Thus far, the results of the Phase II program are exceeding our expectations!

Tara is our first Phase II resident (see her article on page 2), and she will soon be exiting the program on a high note. The additional time has made a huge difference in Tara's life by allowing her to realize, figure out and work on some of the things about herself and her life that have inhibited her from "living" for so long. The added flexibility and responsibility of Phase II as well as the additional love and support have made for a life-changing combination in her life. Shortly before Christmas, she was chosen to receive subsidized housing which will allow her to move out of New Beginnings and into her own place at a greatly reduced (and affordable) rent.

Mia is our second Phase II resident, and she is not far behind. She has efficiently utilized every second of her Phase II time to get her life in order, and her progress is nothing short of remarkable! She has tirelessly volunteered at her church, worked multiple jobs, spoken publicly about her experiences and has enthusiastically encouraged other residents along the way. All this and she is only halfway through her Phase II experience!

Being alone and pregnant may not sound very hopeful, but God does have plans for us "... and we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to His purpose" (Romans 8:28).
