#### THE PRO-LIFE EGG CHALLENGE

It seems the graphic images and inexcusable talk keeps getting worse following the release of *more and more* Planned Parenthood undercover videos that exposed the group's procurement of aborted babies' body parts. *What is our response?* If we say nothing we look like the pagans and if we say too much we sound like the Pharisees. Christians can be accused of voicing their judgments but not putting action to their concerns. Let's walk the talk. We can overcome evil with good (Romans 12:17-21).

The "Pro-Life Egg Challenge" is an effort to raise awareness and funds to support pregnancy resource centers as alternatives to Planned Parenthood. To participate in the challenge you record a video of someone smashing regular unfertilized eggs over your head; upload your video to social media, tagging and challenging at least three of your friends using the hashtag #ProLifeEggChallenge; then you should donate to a pregnancy resource center or home for single mothers. You can donate money or gifts or perhaps volunteer your time. Further we ask participants to consider how they can make a difference beyond the challenge. Perhaps by becoming a foster parent? Adopting a child? Contacting your legislators? *Do you accept the #ProLifeEggChallenge*?
