The Israelites faced this same temptation when they began to grow tired of the manna the Lord provided them each morning.

Even though God rained down miracle nourishment on his people, they complained and said, "If only we had meat to eat! We remember the fish we ate in Egypt at no cost...But now we have lost our appetite; we never see anything but this manna!" (Numbers 11: 4-6). They lost sight of the blessing.

When I began my work at New Beginnings, I fell prey to this temptation. Rather than thanking the Lord for my warm bed and supportive family, I complained when things weren't going exactly right. The mothers at New Beginnings opened my eyes to the things we tend to take for granted. Many did not grow up with a supportive family, or a warm bed, which is why the thought of living at New Beginnings is a constant blessing not to be taken for granted. This serves as an excellent reminder for me and others that we see the beauty in God's constant blessings, and thank him for them. I know the mothers here thank God daily for the blessings he provides them at New Beginnings through you. And I thank him, too, for the opportunity to serve alongside you to provide growth, healing, and hope for moms and their babies. Wishing everyone a Thanksgiving full of blessings, even if they are blessings that are offered all day long! •

"David's Star Lutheran Church, in Jackson, WI has been participating in the Change for Life Program for a number of years, and we find it an easy way to support a wonderful ministry! As our congregation's Parish Nurse, I coordinate this project with our Elders' blessing, but anyone with a desire to serve can do this! I always try to mention New Beginnings in the bulletin or newsletter before we hand out the baby bottles so that people understand why we want to support the ministry. Then, each Mother's Day the baby bottles are made available after services along with a card for people to take home and read. New Beginnings provides the cards, making this nice and easy! In our early years, we asked the Youth Group to help hand out the bottles, or our nurses volunteered to hand them out. But now people are so familiar with the program that they pick up their own! I leave a supply of bottles in an antique porcelain baby bath basin on a table near the church door to create interest and remind those who haven't picked one up yet! Then on Father's Day, we begin to gather the bottles filled with loose change, cash or even a check! It usually takes a few weeks to gather in the bottles, but that's fine with us! I enlist the help of another to take the change to the bank, and then we store the bottles to be used the next year! Call the staff at New Beginnings, as they are happy to send you the bottles needed. Partner with them as they provide a young Mom and her baby a new beginning!" -Sue Bolha
